## **One True God.**

The creation story in the Old Testament states that God made the world out of nothing and gave it to human beings to take care of. Human beings did not manage this task well, and damaged creation beyond human correction. The New Testament tells us that God sent his only Son, Jesus Christ, to fix the problem. Before returning to the Father, Jesus entrusted the new creation into the hands of human beings with the help of the Holy Spirit.

There is a unique relationship in the Godhead. This special relationship forms a community of one God in three persons:

### **Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**

The three persons of God relate to each other at all times, in all places, both in communication and loving relationship. For example....

*If you know me, you know the Father.*

*To have seen me is to have seen the Father. John 14:9.*

*The words I say to you I do not speak as from myself.*

*It is the Father, living in me, who is doing this work. John 14:10*

*I have said these things to you while still with you, but the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all I have said to you. John 14:25*



The symbol of the Holy Spirit as a tongue of fire can help us to better understand this relationship of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. This image contains three separate components—heat, light and fire. These three elements always go together to form a fire. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit have a similar close relationship

Training will be offered on:

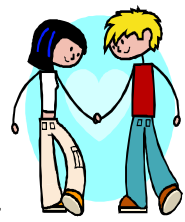
Thursday, June 14th—Parish Office from 10am to 12.30pm.
